MATCH CALLS

At the completion of each match players are to report back to the tournament box to provide the score and to receive following match details. It is each player's responsibility to be at their allocated court ready for their match upon receiving their next match details.

PLAYER BEHAVIOUR

The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with Tennis Australia's Events Disciplinary Policy. AWARDS

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

WET WEATHER

Matches will be held on the indoor courts. Please allow for delayed match scheduling.

TRANSPORT

Car: Parking at Entrance D, via Olympic Blvd. You will be provided with an exit ticket upon sign in. If necessary, please inform the parking officer that you are at Melbourne Park for a tennis tournament.

Tram: Number 70 (Wattle Park), Rod Laver Arena stop

Train: Richmond station. From here patrons can walk approximately 500 metres to Rod Laver Arena

Bus: Number 605 (City – Gardenvale), travels down Exhibition St, Batman Ave and Olympic Blvd (previously known as Swan St). Number 246 (Latrobe Uni – Elsternwick Station), travels down Punt Road, stops at the corner of Olympic Blvd. From here patrons can walk approximately 500 metres to Rod Laver Arena.
